Difficulties in the community
Substance misuse
Social work involvement
Large Families (more than 5 children)
Parents who are isolated due to
language or cultural differences
Displaced Family
Parent has physical disability or
debilitating health issue
Siblings with high level of need
Long Term Unemployment

To make a referral we recommend phoning a project coordinator to discuss. As our service relies on volunteers, we do operate a waiting list while we recruit new volunteers. However, referrers and families are kept up to date and we endeavour to find the best befriending match for the young person.
